

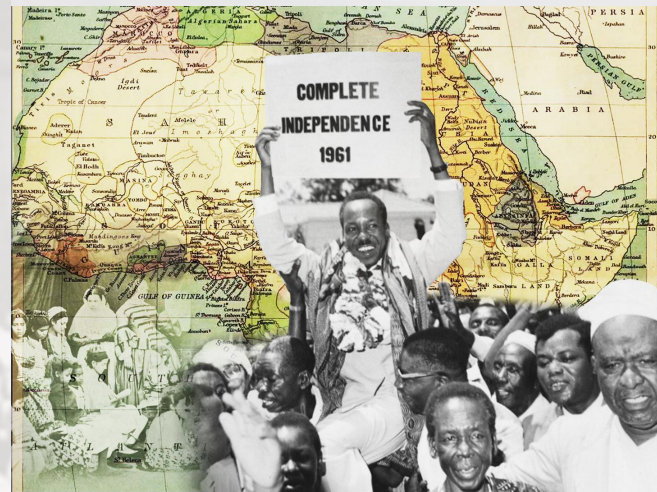
Colonization and Independence in Africa: Teaching about Historical and Contemporary Africa with the Choices Program
